In June, Shirley and her sisters, Jan and Norma, met in Douglasville to see an exhibit that displayed Norma's 1<sup>st</sup> prize photo.

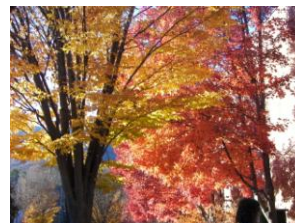
